Internet Privacy and Cookies Policy for www.andrewsandbar.finance

Andrews and Bar Ltd we are committed to safeguarding and preserving the privacy of our visitors. This Policy explains what happens to any personal data that you provide to us, or that we collect from you whilst you visit our site and how we use cookies on this website.

Information That We Collect

In running and maintaining our website we may collect and process the following data about you:

Use of Cookies
